The cars, rules, and safety procedures are designed specifically for kids. Boys and Girls Ages 5-16 race on oval tracks approximately 1/20 of a mile. Safety features include full roll cages, multi-point seat harnesses, full face helmets, arm restraints, and fire suits. This sport has fewer injuries than little league or football. RRQMA is constantly reviewing and evaluating safety rules to ensure that Quarter Midget Racing remains a safe and competitive sport. The racing environment is about children and family. ## PREPARATION FOR RACE SEASON

1. Submit RRQMA Membership Form
  - a. Google form: <https://forms.gle/Gmt2gXaWj1qP3WG89>
  - b. Fee is waived for 1<sup>st</sup> Rookie Year.
  - c. Track keys are \$75 per year to RRQMA and \$125 to Sandia Speedway for insurance. This provides access to the track for practice during non-race days.
  - d. Trailer Spots are \$150 per year if you select during regular drawing or \$75 for new families after drawing, if desired.
    - i. Open front row pit spots are \$20 per race day event.
2. Register for USAC and pay fee (required for racing)
  - a. <https://usacracing.redpodium.com/2023-nascar-youth-series-membership>
    - i. Complete application for Annual Family Membership
    - ii. Fee is \$100 plus \$10 per person in membership per year
3. Pass Safety Inspection
  - a. The quarter midget must be inspected yearly and before training begins. Consult the USAC 0.25 Safety inspection document. Safety gear is also included in the inspection. Safety inspection is conducted by the club's Technical Director. If the car and safety gear pass inspection, a USAC inspection decal will be added to the car which is required for cars to compete.
4. Attend Red Rookie Training Session
  - a. This will prepare your new driver with rules they need to learn as well as what flags mean. This will also include participation in driving a few practice laps. Approval by a rookie trainer is required to begin racing as well as for rookie advancement in classes.
5. Register for races
  - a. Click on the "Driver Registration" link on our website <http://www.roadrunnerqma.com/>
  - b. This link takes you to the My Race Pass website to register for races. First time users will have to create a login.
  - c. Payment for races is taken care of separately through the club's treasurer.
6. RRQMA Race Fees Per Weekend
  - a. PayPal payment to a friend sent to [RRQMANMBT3465@gmail.com](mailto:RRQMANMBT3465@gmail.com) is preferred. Cash or credit card payment with Square are also accepted.
  - b. \$35 per race without ownership of track key for 1<sup>st</sup> car and \$25 for 2<sup>nd</sup> car.
  - c. \$25 per race with ownership of track key for 1<sup>st</sup> car and \$15 for 2<sup>nd</sup> car.
